Raise Above It Fundraising: Overview

- Does the Online Platform option include auto-generated/scheduled emails to remind participants about the fundraiser and deadline? Yes, auto-generated/scheduled emails AND text messages!
- Similar to SIU!, would the fundraiser run for two weeks? What dates in August and September do you have available? Yes, I would recommend that your fundraiser runs for around 2 weeks. If your school signs-up by March 1st, 2025, we will be able to accommodate your first date choice in August or September 2025.
- Is there a website for the fundraiser company that you are with? How long has the company been in business? Yes - www.RaiseAbovelt.com; they have been doing business since 2021.
- Have other schools in the PV district participated in the program? Yes. Are there fundraising stats you can share for PV/AZ schools similar to Sunrise Middle School, which has ~ 400 students? Participating students raise \$192, on average. School results vary with the Online Platform only option as we are not involved in the promotion of the fundraiser such as a kick-off assembly and prizes/incentives.





Officer's Report: President

 - Gained 3 new sign-ups for donations towards the 2/19 staff appreciation meal.








UPC PROGRAM "Facilities Planning in PVUSD": Things the District considers when determining what projects to take on are: Prioritizing student and staff needs at the site level, budget and funding considerations, data-driven decision-making, long-term facility master plans and sustainability, efficiency, and modernization. Choosing a vendor is also an important part of this process. Some things the District looks at when making that choice are: Vendor's processes, pricing, experience, warranty of service, prior performance/reputation, understanding of working with education facilities, and communication practices.
