#### **Teacher Representative's Report**

- DISCUSS/VOTE: Request from a new staff member Look into a company that can create additional SRMS spirit gear

  - New staff members and the rest of the SRMS community would also be interested in additional gear

#### **Officer's Report: President**

- Key amendments to bylaws of Sunrise Middle School PTO:
  - Terms of office: Standard term changed from 1 year to 2 years (if officer is a 7<sup>th</sup> grade parent), with the 2<sup>nd</sup> being a training year for new officers
  - **Effectivity date of elected officers:** Changed from Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> to July 1<sup>st</sup> (in alignment with PVUSD's fiscal calendar)
  - Finances:
    - In addition to payments over \$500, withdrawals over \$500 will now require 2 officers' signatures
    - Added audit clause: At least once per fiscal year, preferably just before the last meeting of the year, a member of the PTO board who does not have bank privileges will audit the finances and present their findings at the next PTO meeting so that there is a record of the audit. Audits may happen more frequently if requested or deemed necessary.
- PTO ways of working
  - Leverage virtual collaboration tools (e.g., shared documents for planning and brainstorming)
  - Organize and track deliverables in a free project management software (ClickUp)
  - **Standardize** and **document** (e.g., procedures book, new officer transition checklist, login information)
  - Monthly staff appreciation meals: Surveys to gauge staff interest and signups for parent donations

#### **Officer's Report: Vice President**

- Outreach
  - Summary of flyers/packets developed for parents and staff
  - Social media posts
  - Monthly newsletter
- Will fill in as interim UPC Representative. First UPC meeting of the school year is on 8/21.

#### **Officer's Report: Treasurer**

- Total current bank balance (8/12/2024): \$5,842.91
- Liabilities: \$1,670.22 (PTO is holding money for these groups.)
  - Dance/Theater: \$998.73
  - Mandarin: \$326.30 (did not spend any money last year)
  - o NJHS: \$195.19
  - Robotics: \$150.00
- PTO: Started the year with \$3,960.29 in checking. Current PTO balance is \$4,172.69 (8/12/2024).
- Spent \$344.78 on: Coffee supplies for staff lounge (\$46.46), serveware (\$30.38), back-to-school breakfast for staff (\$187.34). water bar supplies for 8/14 staff appreciation (\$80.60)
- Have used up over half our Miscellaneous budget purchasing desk fans for office staff (\$101.41).
- Purchased Lysol wipes and tissues for teachers to start the year (\$237.66) under Staff Appreciation budget. Have enough to replenish in December/January.
- Purchased Smore for newsletter creation (\$179.00).
- Received \$110.72 from Kroger.
- Received \$1,055.00 in direct donations (deposited into bank). Still have \$100.00 pending in Zeffy (transfers to our checking account automatically).
- Upcoming expenses:
  - Water delivery on 8/20/2024 \$67.12
  - UPC fee due before 8/21/2024 meeting \$75.00
  - AIM Insurance due 9/1/2024 \$370.00
  - Staff appreciation meal on 9/11/2024 (charcuterie spread)

#### **Old Business**

- School dances, sponsored by STUGO
  - Mrs. Kool supports cutting costs tied to putting on dances (e.g., using less expensive DJ and photo booth vendor).
  - The proposed new DJ and photo booth vendor books up quickly around the holidays and end of the school year, so the sooner we can decide on dates, the better.
  - DISCUSS/VOTE:
    - Solidify dates for dances:
      - 1) 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade dance in Dec.
      - 2) 8<sup>th</sup> grade dance in May
    - Decide **admission fee** (\$5.00?) for Dec. dance (8<sup>th</sup> grade dance in May is free for students)
    - Get approval on providing food for 8<sup>th</sup> grade dance
      - Rationale on providing food: Celebration of students' time at Sunrise and their promotion to high school
      - If approved, will offer grab-and-go food option that is not too messy (e.g., chicken nuggets/strips from Chick-fil-A or Hot Chicken Alley)
      - Will take pre-orders to minimize food waste
      - PTO can check if a restaurant is willing to sponsor the 8<sup>th</sup> grade dance and donate food. Sponsorship package ideas: Advertisement on marquee and/or website, banner

#### **New Business**

- DISCUSS/VOTE:
  - Fundraiser idea for STUGO: Get approval to **sell water, snacks, and/or grab-and-go meals at home games** 
    - Can solicit parent volunteers to help with food sales and cleanup
    - PTO has had offers from Chick-fil-A and Hot Chicken Alley to sell nuggets/strips and/or sandwiches at games. (Hot Chicken Alley was kind enough to donate the food for the end-of-year staff luncheon.)
    - Take pre-orders to minimize food waste
